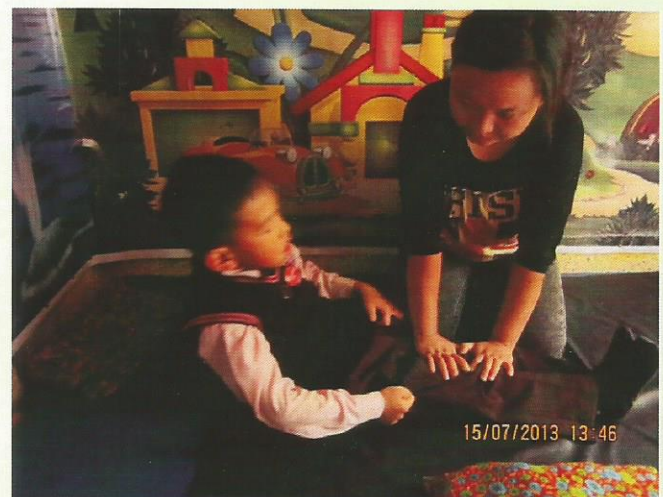

Apart from education the society is catering Physiotherapy to people with disability in the school/ centre and also to the remote places.
